## **REPORT**

GUJCOST Sponsored National Level seminar on

### **“Quality Risk Management in Pharmaceuticals: Concept to Conceptualization”**

29<sup>th</sup> September 2018

A GUJCOST sponsored National seminar entitled ‘**Quality Risk Management in Pharmaceuticals: Concept to Conceptualization**’ was organized by Babaria Institute of Pharmacy, BITS Edu Campus managed by Shree Krishna Educational Charitable Trust, Vadodara on 29<sup>th</sup> September 2018. Dr. Vandana B. Patel, Principal, Babaria Institute of Pharmacy was the Co-ordinator of the seminar. More than 90 delegates, from academia and industry from all over Gujarat, participated in the seminar.

The seminar was inaugurated by the chief guest Mr. J. Ramniwas, CEO, Sai Pharma Solution Inc., Vadodara and Guest of Honor, Dr. (Prof) Vimalkumar, Associate Dean, GTU & Principal, ITM School of Pharmacy, Vadodara. Inaugural function started with prayer and lamp lighting, followed by floral welcome of the guests. Dr. Vandana B. Patel delivered a welcome speech and highlighted the need of Quality Risk Management in Pharmaceutical processes and products. After Inaugural function, first session started by the expert talk of Mr. J. Ramniwas. He discussed the concept of quality risk management and principles of quality risk management.

He emphasized on various quality risk management processes and factors affecting risk management.

Mr. Subhrangshu Chaudhury, AGM, Alembic Pharmaceuticals Ltd., Vadodara was the second distinguished speaker. He delivered a talk on ‘Quality Risk Management Tools and performing CAPA analysis’. He explained identification of qualitative and quantitative risk and discussed various risk management tools and their applicability.

After delicious lunch, Ms. Jignasa Oza, Vice President, IPA, Vadodara deliberated on ‘Out of Specification and Out of Trend Analysis’. She gave a brief idea about OOS & OOT and discussed various phases (I, II, III) of OOS Investigation.

The last lecture of the day was delivered by Dr. Lalji Baldaniya, Associate Professor, Department of Pharmacy, Marwadi University, Rajkot. His topic of deliberation was ‘Performing Failure Mode Effect Analysis’. By giving examples from daily routine, he explained FMEA for pharmaceutical processes. He discussed types of FMEA, creating FMEA and calculation of Risk Priority number (RPN).

Participants actively interacted with the resource persons and shared their views and cleared their doubts about the concept of quality risk management. They gave feedback about need of conducting more of such seminar on current topics demanded by industry.

Dr. Dimal Shah, Associate Professor and Co Coordinator of the seminar, summarized the whole day of the seminar and proposed vote of thanks. The function ended with national anthem.
