With the optimistic viewpoint of holistic development of teachers, Babaria Institute of Pharmacy has organized GTU-AICTE sponsored one week faculty development program on “Teaching Pedagogy : An Effective Tool for Efficient Teaching” from 30th December 2019 to 4th January 2020, where highly learned speakers touched almost all aspects of teaching pedagogy.

Day 1 Date: 30th Dec 2019

Speaker 1: Dr. Sulabha Natraj, Hon. Director Shri H M Patel English Medium Schools’ Complex, Dharmaj

She made a deliberation on effective classroom management. She drew attention of delegates to the fact that teacher is no more a sage on the stage and we need to transform our earning ability to learning agility to serve as true educators. She explained various techniques for effective class management.

Speaker 2: Dr. Dipti Oza, Professor in Education, Coordinator, PG Diploma in Guidance and Counseling, The M. S. University of Baroda, Vadodara

She enlightened the delegates with specific differences in education at school and university level. Madam highlighted the productive role of a mentor and insisted to develop mature sense of identity. She elaborated the strategies to be incorporated in educational institutions for fruitful teaching learning. He taught how to use animations and other modern tools for effective presentations. All the participants got actively indulged in making animations during his workshop.

Day 3 Date: 1st Jan 2020

Speaker: Dr. Mahendra Chotalia, Ex-Professor, Department of Education, S. P. University, Anand

The expert delivered the talk on innovative teaching pedagogy. He gave tips of how to lecture without lecturing with live examples and how to bring innovations in classroom to improve student engagement and enhance their thinking ability.

Day 4 Date: 2nd Jan 2020

Speaker 1: Dr. Vandana Patel, Principal, Babaria Institute of Pharmacy, Vadodara

Madam highlighted the importance of managing life along with time and vice-versa to attain balance in professional as well as personal life. She explained one should never be overstressed as it affects mental health, affects the time and it leads to poor performance in the college.
